Burnt Sienna

Cadmium Orange or Vermilion

Chinese White

Yellow Ochre and gamboge

Prussian Blue

Brush(es): Sable, Lamb, Horse or Wolf (one medium size a must)

Water Vessel

Palette (white)

Felt (1/2 yard)

Paper weight for rice paper (rock, glass, metal, etc.)
