- 6 canvas boards or stretched canvas 12x16 or 11x 14
- 3 brushes- Grumbacher Academy Synthetic (sable-type) Brushes; one filbert or bright, one round, and one flat. medium size-\$5.00 each total \$10
- A palette knife - steel, stepped, medium size- \$3 to \$4
