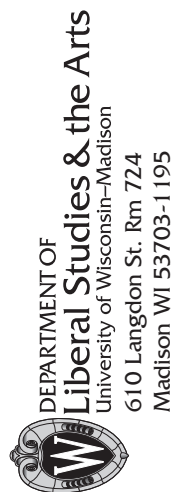

Saturday, December 27

Depart the U.S. for England through Chicago O'Hare.

Monday, December 29

Morning **educational seminars** over coffee. After a free afternoon you'll rejoin the group for an evening performance of the opera **Turandot**.

Tuesday, December 30

Morning **walking tour** of *Shakespeare's London*. Enjoy a free afternoon and in the evening attend a concert to be announced.

Wednesday, December 31

Morning guided tour of the **Abstract Expressionism Gallery** at the *Tate Modern Museum*. After another free afternoon, enjoy an elegant group meal at *Searcy's* in the Barbican Center before attending the **New Year's Eve Gala** with the *Royal Philharmonic Orchestra*.

Thursday, January 1

New Year's Day is yours to spend as you wish. We'll have optional tickets if you'd like to attend the **New Year's Day Gala** at the Barbican Center. The evening is free for you to choose your own entertainment.

Friday, January 2

The day is unscheduled. Join your companions for a farewell **group meal** at our traditional location, the Italian restaurant *Trattoria Verdi* before attending the classical ballet, **Manon**, performed by the *English National Ballet*.
